

# Dance Data Project® Data Byte

## Women-Founded U.S. Ballet and Classically Based Companies 2024

In honor of the women shaping the dance industry, Dance Data Project® has compiled a listing of women-founded ballet and classically based professional companies in the United States. To the extent possible, DDP has reached out to the greater dance community to source female founders. We are, however, cognizant that there likely will be additional women and companies sourced going forward.

Keeping track of these female-founded ballet companies is vital in understanding the pivotal and often unknown role of women in shaping the American ballet sector. These companies represent the talent, groundbreaking innovation, and perseverance of their female founders, and their significant impact on the evolution of ballet

especially regionally. They serve as inspiration to aspiring dancers, choreographers, and leaders within the industry, challenging norms and pushing boundaries.

The [Chicago Opera Ballet](#) was the first American ballet company and was established in 1910. In [1929](#), Dorothy Alexander was the first woman to establish a ballet company when she started the Atlantic Civic Ballet, later becoming the currently active Atlanta Ballet. This achievement helped pave the way for future women-founded ballet companies.

It is important to note, many of the female-founded companies were established before important laws were enacted to protect women's rights. This includes laws like the

Equal Pay Act ([1963](#)) which ensured women were paid fairly, and the Equal Opportunity in Education Act ([1972](#)) which provided equal education opportunities regardless of gender. Additionally, women weren't granted the right to open a bank account or apply for a credit card on their own until [1974](#). These instances highlight the significant obstacles many women faced and overcame to establish successful ballet companies.

In this Data Byte, DDP has gathered information for 183 ballet companies founded or co-founded by women between 1929 and 2024. The Data Byte further distinguishes between currently active and defunct/inactive companies.

## Methods & Limitations

DDP sourced founder names, gender, and years active primarily from company websites, social media, news articles, archival news articles, and the New York Public Library's Archives and Manuscripts online search. Pronouns were used as an indicator of gender. The companies included in this Data Byte were gathered from the sources listed previously and from DDP's annual Largest US Ballet and Classically Based Companies Report. All information was collected in a shared Google Spreadsheet. Following initial data collection, data was reviewed and verified by a separate research team member for accuracy.

DDP also requested input from the public via social media platforms for additional women-founded ballet companies in the US for inclusion in this Data Byte. We extend our gratitude to those who responded for their contributions. DDP especially wants to acknowledge Diana Byer and Dr. Elizabeth McPherson for responding to our request and providing additional founders included in this Data Byte.

Despite our best efforts, DDP acknowledges the possibility that not all women-founded ballet companies are included in this Data Byte, particularly inactive companies. Many defunct and inactive companies no longer have websites or never had an online presence, and archival press information is also scarce. This underscores the significance of historical archives in preserving women's contributions to the dance industry. At this time, DDP has only collected information on U.S. based ballet companies, but intends to expand to include U.S. based contemporary and modern companies, as well as ballet companies outside the United States. DDP is also interested in exploring the longevity of women-founded companies v. those founded by men.
